The unique 'groove and groove' design of Therrawood decking systems present a clean, unobstructed profile that enables proper drainage. All installation is completed using hidden fasteners made of stainless steel. Our special design allows unsightly electrical wires to be hidden inside the decking and the posts. The combination of these features provides an appealing appearance of a high quality product.

### Decking

Therrawood decking boards have dual surfaces and it is recommended that you choose carefully which face you install.

If the decking is going to have to withstand heavy use that could cause scratching or staining (for example pets) we would recommend laying Therrawood decking with the ribbed side up.








#### Therrawood Decking

#### Questions you will need to ask!

- What is the m² of decking required?
- How many sides will need trim? (Deck trim (8) deck cover profile (15) hybrid plinth (9) available or deck caps (11)
- What are they fixing to? If existing timber,
   joist may not be required. If directly onto concrete
   or paving, use composite joist.
- Joist should be fixed with buildex screws (14)
   if directly onto concrete or paving
- If the deck is raised use pedestals and hybrid joists (12 + 3)


- For raised decking cross beams use Joist corner bracket (4)
  - To join two hybrid joists, use Joist extension bracket (5)
- Joist centres should be no more than
   350mm centres
- 1m<sup>2</sup> = 2 deck boards
- 1m<sup>2</sup> = 20 hidden fasteners
- 1m<sup>2</sup> = 3.5 LM of joist





# Railings

Although railings are often one of the last items to be selected and installed they are often the most prominent feature in any outdoor space. Until now you could chose from vinyl with its plastic chalky look, aluminum which will eventually oxidize or hollow composite products often requiring inserts for strength. We were not happy with those choices and as a result, designed our own hybrid system. Our railing system not only looks great but offers several advantages unique to our product.





#### Therrawood Railings

#### Questions you will need to ask!

- How many meters of railing do you need? (our set size is 1.8m long by 1.2m tall)
- Are there any angles in the railing? (if yes, we will need to use Top and bottom rail swivel brackets vertical and horizontal (13 + 14)
- Are you using railing on stairs? (if yes, we will need to use Top and bottom rail swivel brackets vertical and horizontal (13 + 14)






#### Therrawood Fencing

#### Questions you will need to ask!

- Configuration of fence line. Is it a straight line or does it have right angles?
   You will need this to determine which posts are required.
- Are you surface mounting or sinking in the ground?
- If surface mounting will need fixing plates? (7/8/9)
- Do you want closed or semi closed fencing?
- Semi closed module is 1.5m width and closed is 1.8m width

#### Therrawood Care and Maintenance



#### **General Cleaning**

Use soapy water and a soft brush, hose down the surface after brushing.



#### **Stubborn Stains**

Use Therrawood deck cleaner and follow the instructions on the packaging.



#### **Deep Cleaning**

Use a jet wash (using the fan spray) at approx. 250mm away from the surface to clear the deck of debris.



#### **Snow and Ice**

Avoid using metal tools that could damage the decking surface to clear snow or ice.
